4. The said premises shall at all times be kept in a strictly clean and sanitary condition; the permittee will observe and comply with the rules and regulations of the health authorities applicable to the said premises, and will not dispose of garbage, refuse and waste off of the said premises except at a place or places indicated by the Superintendent, or his agent. The Navy Facility will be under the cognizance of the Navy Bureau of Medicine and Surgery for health and sanitary matters.

5. It will be the responsibility of the permittee to repair and revegetate all breaks in the barrier dunes caused by construction activities and to take whatever maintenance measures may be necessary to preserve the dunes, including providing wooden ramps over and across the dunes wherever vehicular access or recurrent personnel access to the beach may be necessary.

6. The conducting of mining operations, removal of any sand, gravel or kindred substances, or permitting the same to be done by others, without the consent in writing of the Superintendent is prohibited. Dredging and filling may be carried out within the area as necessary to improve drainage and carry out construction.

7. The permittee shall be governed by, and inform all personnel of the Navy installation that they must observe and comply with, the rules and regulations of the National Park Service and such special rules and regulations as are now, or hereafter may be applicable to the Cape Hatteras National Seashore.

8. The permittee agrees to cooperate with the authorities of the Cape Hatteras National Seashore in emergencies and to assist the Superintendent to extinguish fires in the vicinity of the tract.

9. This permit shall not be assigned or sublet, nor will the permittee part with the possession of the whole or any part of said premises without the consent in writing of the Director, National Park Service.

10. Should the premises covered by this permit be abandoned or not used for a continuous period of six months or longer, the Director, National Park Service or his agent may enter upon and take possession of said premises and at his option terminate this agreement.

11. The permittee shall remove all structures, foundations, and pavements, and clean up and restore the site prior to or immediately following termination of use.

12. This permit may be terminated upon breach of any of the conditions herein or at the discretion of the Director, National Park Service.
